

Gladesville Primary School Child Safe Standard 7 September 2019

Purpose

To ensure the school has strategies to promote child empowerment and participation, meeting Child Safe Standard 7.

Scope

This policy applies to all school activities, including camps and excursions.

Policy

All Victorian schools are required to meet the seven Child Safe Standards, to ensure that they are well prepared to protect children from abuse, family violence and neglect.

Requirements for these standards are set out in <u>Ministerial Order 870</u> (MO 870) and compliance is monitored by the VRQA.

Under CSS-7 schools are required to <u>deliver appropriate education about</u>:

Element 1: Standards of behaviour for students attending the school.

Element 2: Healthy and Respectful Relationships

Element 3: Resilience

Element 4: Child Abuse Awareness and Protection

Gladesville Primary School has developed a range of strategies to promote engagement, positive behaviour and respectful relationships for all students in our school. We acknowledge that some students may need extra social, emotional or educational support at school, and that the needs of students will change over time as they grow and learn.
